Black ants, Brown house ants, Sugar ants, Meat ants, Argentine ants	Exterior of domestic buildings and gardens	Sprinkle ANTEX 50 granules lightly around nest and trails wherever ants are active. DO NOT apply inside building.

In Western Australia, Argentine Ants must be reported to the Department of Agriculture. Argentine ants are not pests in Queensland.

GROUP 1B INSECTICIDE

For insecticide resistance management ANTEX 50 is a Group 1B insecticide.

Some naturally occurring insect biotypes resistant to Antex 50 and other Group 1B insecticides may exist through normal genetic variability in any insect population. The resistant individuals can eventually dominate the insect population if Antex 50 or other Group 1B insecticides are used repeatedly. The effectiveness of Antex 50 on resistant individuals could be significantly reduced. Since occurrence of resistant individuals is difficult to detect prior to use, David Gray & Company accepts no liability for any losses that may result from the failure of Antex 50 to control resistant insects.

Antex 50 may be subject to specific resistance management strategies. For further information contact your local supplier, David Gray & companies' representative or local agricultural department.
