DIRECTIONS FOR USE

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING: To produce a healthy well conditioned coat, apply shampoo to wet animal, rub well in, rinse and dry animal thoroughly. Weekly use of this product is recommended.

HOW TO TREAT FLEAS

To ensure the best results from this product it is very important that your pet's environment is also treated, as your pet can be continually re-infected from an untreated environment. It is important to continue treatment throughout the year. To ensure maximum flea control:

1. Treat other pets in the household.
2. Treat the carpets and your pet's bedding and kennels with a flea spray or flea powder. Wash or replace bedding regularly.
3. Vacuum the carpets regularly and discard debris.
