<p>Outside: Abattoirs, animal housing, garbage containers, food processing plants.</p> <p>Around: Industrial sites, feedlot manure heaps, garbage dumps.</p>	<p>Adult houseflies (<i>Musca domestica</i>)</p>	<p>2.5g/m²</p>	<p>Dry Bait: Broadcast or scatter bait widely over the area directly from the container, or with a scoop.</p> <p>OR Set up bait stations by sprinkling into shallow tins, lids or similar containers and place where flies congregate. Position bait stations out of reach of animals or poultry and away from feed troughs, storage or mixing areas.</p> <p>Wet Bait: In many situations more flies can be attracted by sprinkling bait on moist hessian sacks, placed out of reach of all livestock.</p> <p>Re-baiting: Re-baiting will be necessary in 3-5 days depending on exposure, weather and density of fly populations.</p>
<p>Inside: Animal houses ONLY in areas inaccessible to livestock.</p> <p>Under: Animal and poultry cages ONLY in areas inaccessible to livestock.</p>			<p>Set up dry bait stations as above. PROTECTION OF WILDLIFE, FISH, CRUSTACEANS AND ENVIRONMENT:

Do NOT place baits in locations which are accessible to domestic animals, livestock or birds.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

Store in the closed, original container in a dry, cool, well-ventilated area out of direct sunlight. Triple or preferably pressure rinse containers before disposal. Disposal of rinsings in a disposal pit specifically marked and set up for this purpose, clear of waterways, desirable vegetation and tree roots. Break, crush or puncture and bury empty containers in a local authority landfill. If no landfill is available, bury the containers below 500 mm in a disposal pit. Empty containers and product should not be burnt.

Poisonous if swallowed. Avoid contact with eyes and skin. Do not touch bait. Use scoop or measure. If on skin, and after each baiting, wash thoroughly with soap and water.

FIRST AID:

If swallowed, give one atropine tablet every 5 minutes until dryness of mouth occurs
– if poisoned by skin absorption or through lungs, remove any contaminated clothing,
wash skin thoroughly and give atropine tablets as above. Get to a doctor or hospital
quickly.
