EXPOSURE LIMITS:

NOT DETERMINED.

VENTILATION:

GOOD VENTILATION IS REQUIRED WHEN MIXING OR HANDLING THE CONCENTRATE. AVOID BREATHING THE VAPOUR.

PERSONAL PROTECTION:

CLEAN BODY COVERING IMPERVIOUS CLOTHING AND GLOVES. TWIN CARTRIDGE RESPIRATOR WITH AGRICULTURAL FILTERS IS RECOMMENDED. FACE SHIELD OR GOGGLES SHOULD BE WORN WHEN MIXING THE CONCENTRATE OR SPRAYING TO AVOID SPRAY DRIFT.

FLAMMABILITY:

STORAGE AND TRANSPORT:
