SITUATION	PEST	HOW TO APPLY
Home Garden	Ants, Aphids, Thrips, Plant Bugs, Caterpillars, Flies and Mosquitoes	Hold bottle upright and spray infested plant lightly at a range of 50cm. Spray all foliage including under surface of leaves. Spray in calm conditions after watering and avoid spraying during the heat of the day.
